"KIDS TIMEL TABLETS", taken once a day, reduce nervous excitement caused by vehicle sway and acceleration, and reduce or relieve the occurrence of dizziness, nausea and headache caused by motion sickness. If you use about 30 minutes before getting on a car, ship, airplane etc, you will be relieved from unpleasant motion sickness, thereby making travel and excursion more fun.

Contains saccharin sodium, lactose, potato starch, hydroxypropyl cellulose, calcium stearate, cellulose, silicon dioxide, and Blue No. 1.

[Indication]

For the prevention and treatment of dizziness, nausea, headache associated with motion sickness.

When not use the product

1 While taking this medicine, please do not take any of the following medicines.

Other medicines such as motion sickness medicine, cold medicine, antipyretics, analgesics, sedatives, antitussive expectorants, gastrointestinal analgesic antispasmodics, internal medicines containing antihistamine etc. (internal medicine for rhinitis, allergy medicine etc.)

2 After taking this medicine, do not drive a car or operate machinery

(symptoms such as sleepiness, blurred vision and abnormal brightness may occur).

Please take the following amounts



children 3 to under 11 years	1 tablet	(Please take this medicine within 30 minutes before getting on board such as cars or ships for prevention of motion sickness.)
children under 3 years	Do not use	

(When using this product)

- (1) Please follow the recommended dosage and directions.
- (2) This medicine should be given to children only under adult supervision.
- (3) When administering this medicine to children over 3 years oid, be careful not to get the medicine stuck in their throat.
- (4) When using this medicine for the first time,

Please push the projection of the PTP sheet containing tablets strongly with your fingertips as shown below, break the aluminum sheet on the back side, push out and take it.

(If you mistakenly swallow the PTP sheet as it is, it leads to an unexpected accident such as stabbing into the esophagus mucosa)



(5) This medicine can be drunk without water, but if you melt in the mouth, bitterness comes out, please swallow early.

[Precautions for storage and handling]

- (1) Store it in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight.
- (2) Keep all medicine out of the reach of children.
- (3) Do not transfer this medicine to a different container. (In this case, cause misuse or change quality)
- (4) Please do not take this medicine that have passed the expiration date
